



WideWorld Sports Center Introduces All New Membership System

Team Managers,

Please take the time to read the following statement from WideWorld Sports Center and pass onto your teammates.

After careful consideration, WideWorld enacted a **yearly membership fee** for all activities **effective at the beginning of the Fall 1 Season** (Sept. 6). The membership fee allows participants to register for all youth and adult leagues, camp programs, and developmental courses. The 2011-12 team fees are the same as the past couple of seasons.

The yearly membership fee is \$15 per individual, and \$30 for families (4-person limit). For all youth and adult teams the fee is required before any team member can take the field of play.

Those that do not have a membership should click on the link that says Start My Membership. All members create their own username and password.

Once you have created a membership and paid the fee you will then be able to register a team or add your name to a team roster. Players will still be able to roster and play on as many teams as they would like, although you cannot play on more than one team per division.

Failure to pay the membership fee or properly roster onto a team may result in game forfeitures or suspension from playing at WideWorld.

Please be aware that team managers will no longer be able to roster players onto their team roster. Payment of the membership fee can be made in person by cash, check, or credit card.

The following will help describe what WideWorld intends to do with the monies collected from a yearly fee:

1. **Facility Upgrades** - upgrades will include but are not limited to: computer kiosks for efficient management of rosters and registrations; new turf fields; re-surfacing of the parking lot; roof treatments; and continuous upgrades to the new quarter-million dollar water treatment center.



2. **Parking lot security** - WideWorld has implemented hidden cameras as well as parking lot security to help curb potential theft, while also giving our customers the satisfaction of knowing that their personal belongings remain safe.

3. **Rewards Program** - WideWorld offers a rewards program that benefits short and long-term participants that includes, or may in the future include the following:

- a. Free pick-up play for individuals or groups M-F 12-2:30 p.m.
- b. Youth and Adult Team discounts for playing in consecutive seasons.
- c. Developmental Program discounts.
- d. Camp Program Discounts.
- e. Field Rental Discounts.

Certainly, there will be more upgrades to the facility, as well as other rewards programs that will be initiated over time. Though fees are generally considered as likable as taxes, we hope that you understand that the membership fee is necessary, and that all monies generated will be put back into the facility as upgrades, rewards, or benefits to the customer.
